We are excited to announce that we have just kick-started a new clinical trial in September with Aevice Health, a Singapore-based MedTech company, and clinicians from NUH.

The clinical trial aims to investigate the use of Aevice Health's proprietary device, AeviceMD, to detect wheezing in pediatric patients with breathing difficulties.


AeviceMD is a wearable respiratory monitor that can record chest sounds remotely and continuously. The recorded sounds would be used to red flag abnormalities such as wheezing. With more patients turning towards telemedicine since the pandemic, remote monitoring devices could provide insightful data to health providers.

Leveraging on one of our core strengths of conducting clinical validation, CIH is happy to facilitate and coordinate this trial.
