CIH SUPPORTED YOUNG INNOVATOR: PAPER BREATH

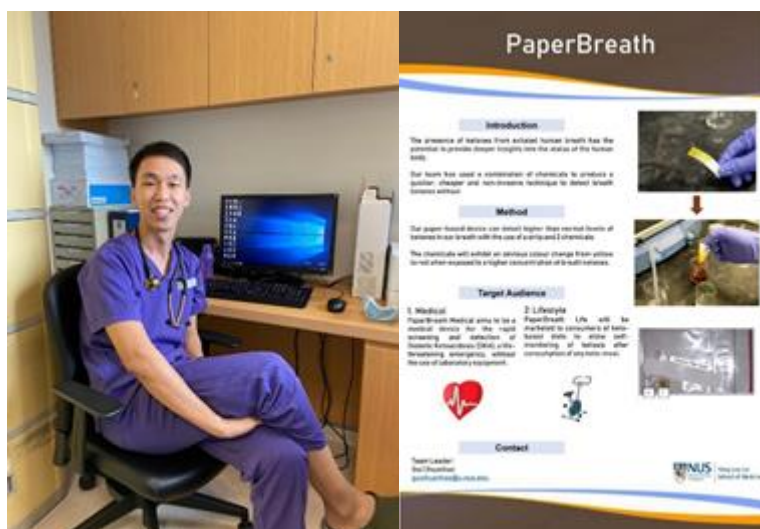
CIH continues to support and nurture young innovators and share our vision of transforming the future of healthcare.

We have been supporting medical students and innovators with our advisors and mentors. These medical students include past teams from the **Medical Grand Challenge (MGC)**, an initiative led by students from NUS Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine (NUS Medicine), who also participated in CIH's **Innovation 360° SEED**, an annual event organized by our Centre. We like to express our appreciation of thanks to our donor, **Lotus Life Foundation**, who has pledged a sum of money to establish the LOTUS-NUS Healthcare Innovation Fund to provide seed funding for selected healthcare innovation projects to take their projects to the next phase of innovation journey.

One of the teams that is still under our close mentorship until today is team **PAPER BREATH** who swept the first prize in MGC 2018. Their innovation is a novel and non-invasive method of diagnosing diabetic ketoacidosis (DKA), a life-threatening medical condition affecting people with diabetes, through patients' breath. Paper Breath has since registered their business, Breath Technologies, and is collaborating with one of CIH's partners iHealthtech to refine their prototype for commercialisation.

MGC 2020 has successfully concluded last month. CIH will continue to support and mentor the winning teams.
